


In closing, I wish you all a great year ahead.

Dr Sharath Rao, President, KOA welcomed the members present and thanked them for being part of this conference. He also spoke briefly about the Conference and its logistics saying that 570 delegates were participating in this conference.

Next the obituaries of :- Dr.Gyanchand, Dr. Raju S.M, Dr. Anand, Dr. Satyendra Rao, Dr.Nitya Naik were noted and a minute of silence was observed by the house, in a mark of respect to the above departed souls.

Secretary General Dr. Purushotham V.J read out the report of KOA 2012-13 . The logistics of setting up of KOA office at Bangalore were presented and the report was accepted by the house.

Dr. Vasudev Kamath presented the report of accounts of KOA upto 2012 . It was accepted by the AGM.

Statement of accounts of KOACON 2012 was next presented by Dr.Vijai Murakhibhavi and was accepted.

President Sharath Rao and Secretary Dr. Purushotham felicitated Dr Murakhibhavi for the highest ever contribution to KOA of Rs 3 Lakhs.

The KOA-IOU-UK traveling fellowship report:- was read out by Dr. Sreeranga. Dr Neelanna Gouda Patil submitted his report to the President. The cheques of Rupees Fifty Thousand (Rs 50,000/-) each was forwarded to both the fellows by the sponsor Mr. Murthy, President of Santhosha Charitable Trust.

Dr. Manjunath T presented the report of Inland fellowship; He was given a cheque for Rupees Twenty Thousand (Rs 20, 000/-) by President Dr. Sharath Rao.

The Secretary announced that 89 members had applied for membership and their memberships were ratified by the house.

Secretary and Election Officer Dr. Purushotham presented the election report.

In the second newsletter of the KOA election date was announced. 22nd Dec was declared as the last date to receive the nominations and 27th Dec as the last date for withdrawals. Six candidates had applied for the post of president and two withdrew from the election; Six members had applied for EC members and were elected unopposed. Lone applicant for the post of Vice President OASIS , Dr Sharath Rao, was elected unopposed.

The counting of ballot was done under the supervision of Presiding Officer Dr. Sharath Rao. Election Officer Dr.Purushotham V.J and, representatives of all the candidates were involved in the counting. Dr. Nithyanand was declared-elected as, President Elect for 2013-2014, by the Election Officer.

Dr. Gubbi, congratulated the President and the Secretary for conducting a fair election procedure. However he questioned the validity of counting ballots received after 25th, i.e., 28th and 29th.

Presiding officer Dr. Sharath Rao, explained the usual procedure where-in the opinion of the candidates or his representatives were taken before counting those ballots, and only upon their consent, ballots received on 28th and 29th, were counted. Dr. Sagar added that the same procedure was practiced in previous years also.

Dr.Kaladagi raised an objection about campaigning; along with Dr. John Ebnezer he stressed for a need to ban all forms of campaigning in our elections.

Dr. Parthasarathy raised the issue of a few duplicate ballot papers. Election Officer Dr. Purushotham clarified that there were 18 duplicate ballot papers sent inadvertently .The recipient members were contacted and informed about this and they were requested to send back only one ballot paper . He also informed the house that there was no incidence of receiving double ballot paper from the same member. Dr Sharath Rao added that not a single double voting was detected while counting .

Dr. Purushotham also informed that 25th was not a holiday for post office and courier-, hence it was considered as last day for receiving the ballot papers.

After deliberations and discussions by some senior members present, the following reforms and code of conduct were proposed from next election onwards:-

- a) The election campaign should be only through post, email and sms. No personal meetings or parties to be allowed lest it should attract disqualification.
- b) The last date for receiving complaints for nonreceipt of ballot paper should also be announced. The complaint must be from the member and it should be sent by email or sms to the Election officer.
- c) The last date for receiving the ballot paper should not be on holidays or restricted holidays.
- d) The Election Officer should bring all the ballots received by him but only the ballots received till the announced last dates should be counted. If there is a tie the other ballots should be counted.
- e) Only the candidate or one of his representatives should be allowed during counting.
- f) The Secretary is the Election Officer and the President is the Presiding officer while counting, and the President Elect will assist him.
- g) If the identity slip is not enclosed the ballot should be considered invalid. Likewise if the identity slip is enclosed in the same cover as ballot paper it should be invalid.
- h) If the ballot paper cover is found opened it is in valid.

Nomination of five senior members as advisors for the Secretariat:-

Dr. Rajeev Naik, Dr.J.S Hedge, Dr BB Putti , Dr R.R.Shah and Dr. Shantharam Shetty were nominated for last year and continued for this year as well. They will advice the Secretary whenever required.

Dr. Shaarth Rao briefed on the KPA Journal which will be published by the Secretariat. He said it would be financed by proceedings of the conference and some industry support . Dr. Edward Nazareth was to be the editor till 2014. Dr Edward said it would be feasible to publish one volume of the journal per year at present.

Dr. Edward submitted the report on guidelines for the district club affiliation to KOA. The house agreed for staged implementation of it. The President and Secretary had a look into this.

EC members in IOA from KOA are to be Coopted members of KOA .

The KOA web site is to be under control of the Secretariat.

Dr. Deepak.S informed the house that he and Dr. Naresh Shetty have requested for relieving them from the posts of Co-ordinator and Chairperson of KOA-IOSUK Travelling Fellowship from this year. Dr. Rajiv Naik opined that there should be a change in the posts after a certain period. The house selected the following names:

The President and Secretary General are the members for that year. Other members are Dr. Vijay Murakibhavi and Dr. Ajith Kumar .

Dr. Deepak proposed to name the fellowship in the name of Dr. BN Muddu, the patron of this fellowship. The house accepted it. Dr. Deepak also said that an MOU had been drafted to strengthen this fellowship in future.

Dr. Sharath suggested that a fee of Rs.100/- per delegate be given to the KOA Secretariat.

Dr. Purushotham, Secretary stressed on the need for free camps, charity activities and free treatments to attain 12/a status for IT purposes. He also suggested changing the auditor to achieve this. It was decided by the house to undertake free camps, charitable activities, treatments and keep the Secretariat informed on time.

Dr. Rajendra, President Elect, presented his team for 2013:-

Dr. Chadrashekar HS as Organizing Secretary; Dr. Narendra H.S. as Treasurer.

EC members Dr. Gopinath, Mysore; Dr. Girish, Bangalore; Dr. Hemanth, Bijapur; Dr. Manjunath TS, Bangalore;

Dr Ramesh Krishna, Bangalore; Dr. Shivanand, Bangalore; Dr Ajay Hedge, Mysore; Dr. Badrinath Murthy, Bangalore;

Dr. Nithin Srichand, Mysore; Dr. Shiva Naik, Bellary; Dr. Subodh Shetty, Bangalore; Dr. Subodh Shetty, Davangere;

Dr. Venkatesh Mulmani, HUBLI.

He also proposed to present a trophy of Rs. 25,000/- to the best performing district clubs, to be paid by the President. A committee comprising of the President, Secretary General, and two senior members will supervise this, he added. A Chairman for district relationship committee was proposed to be appointed by the President.

He proposed to name it after the Late Dr. Sudhakar Shetty. The house opined it to be called as KOA Best District Club Trophy.

He proposed to institute the Best thesis award of Rs 10,000/- for Post graduates to be funded by KOACON.

He also proposed to institute the Best Publication award of Rs 5000/- in the indexed journal, also to be funded by KOACON.

He also proposed to start the KOA Life time Achievement award but the house turned it down.

He suggested that the President Elect to be on the Dais during the AGM and given some time to talk. It was accepted by the house.

He also proposed to bring in electronic voting. The President Elect should be given the responsibility of initiating the process in consultation with the Election Officer and Secretary General.

The guide lines for KOA-ICL was presented by Dr. Manoj. The House suggested that it be implemented in a phased manner. The President and Secretary are to look into the matter.

The meeting was concluded with the Secretary Dr. Purushotham thanking the members and playing of the national anthem.

## MINUTES OF FIRST E.C. MEETING (KOA) - BANGALORE, 3rd March 2013

General Secretary Dr. Purushotham V.J . welcomed the members and invited the President to address the members. President , Dr Rajendra started the proceedings of the meetings by addressing the members.

The President congratulated all EC members and sought their active participation in the programmes of KOA. He said that he has nominated Dr. Badrinath as Chairman of the district co-ordination committee. He requested Dr. Badrinath to liaise with the Secretary and initiate the related activities including informing the district level associations meeting and updating members data.

The President proposed the following:-

- Grading system for district clubs and marks to be awarded according to their activities. The best club to be awarded Rs. 25,000/- at KOACON, from KOACON fund
- Affiliation of district clubs to KOA to be done in a staged manner.
- 1) to be registered as Trust or Society
- 2) to have a PAN number and audited accounts
- 3) District should have a minimum of five and maximum fifty to be enrolled as members

Dr. R. Badrinath is given the responsibility of getting the contacts of office bearers of all clubs through their local office and to report to KOA within two months about the progress. Also to motivate the office bearers to register all clubs in two months.

- Membership drive was emphasized
- EC members should take individual responsibility to get new members to register- ten IOA and five KOA.
- Best dissertation award for Post Graduated and a committee to be constituted.
- H O D's of all medical colleges should recommend one dissertation to KOA. Dr. Anil Nevalgi from Davanagere to be the co-ordinator of this committee which is to select the award through KOACON fund of Rs10,000/-.

President also proposed that in future, in the event of the KOACON committee failing to pay for the above awards, the KOA Secretariat should step in to support it.

Best article in Indian or western journals to be given Rs 5000/- from KOACON.

Best paper presentation Rs 1000 /-, Best poster award of Rs1000/- to be given at the conference by KOACON.

Dr. Sharath Rao said that Rs. 100 per delegate be paid towards KOA starting from KOACON 2013. It was accepted by all.

Inland KOA fellowship amount is increased to Rs 20,000 per candidate .

Secretary Dr. Purushotham read his report. He thanked Past President Dr. Sharath Rao for having conducted a wonderful conference at Manipal. He also congratulated Dr. Nithyanand Rao for having been elected as President elect.

Dr. Manoj as Joint Secretary and Dr. Roshan as Treasurer were re nominated for this year also. Dr. Nithyananda Rao requested the Secretary to assign some responsibilities to the Joint Secretary and Treasurer. Dr. Purushotham said that Dr. Roshan has been given the responsibility of introducing identity cards to all KOA members. Dr. Nithyanand suggested publishing a directory after updating all contacts.

The Secretary also said that KOA society registration has not been renewed for the last four years. Dr. Manoj was given the responsibility of initiating the process of renewal of registration under the guidance of the Secretary and to report by the next EC meeting. Dr. Purushotham said that it may require huge finance for renewal of longer periods in Bangalore.

The past and present president along with the President Elect shall take a decision on the expenditure required for the same, and complete the process by the next EC meeting.

Dr Purushotham informed that a notice has been received by the IT department for wrong assessment of accounts asking for a penalty of four Lacs. He also said that the auditor has promised to settle it by March 31st 2013. He also said that the change of auditor could only happen after the settlement of this issue. All the activities to be updated from respective places and reported to the Secretary and to be released in the news letter.

Past President Dr. Sharath Rao read his report :-

He thanked the Secretariat and all the previous EC members for their co operation during his tenure. The following are the contributions:

- I. Rs 57,5000/- paid to the Secretary (100 per delegate at KOACON) .Rs 40,000/- paid on the last day of KOACON 2013 to President Dr. Rajendra as seed money.
