




MINUTES OF THE AGM HELD ON 6-02-2021

Hybrid AGM - Hotel Ramanashree, Bangalore

The Meeting Started after the quorum was reached.

Dr. Roshan Kumar, Secretary General welcomed the gathering and explained to the audience about how the virtual interactive meeting was arranged.

President Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy addressed the gathering and gave welcome address. He described about the various programs conducted during his tenure. A few to mention were - 2 physical meets, 41 virtual meets include webinars every fortnight, Virtual CMEs, Virtual Talks, etc...

A dedicated PG teaching program was also initiated during his term, where all the HODs of various medical colleges across Karnataka were members in the program. 30 such PG programs were held.

The outgoing president requested the incoming president to continue all the academic programs started during his term.

Secretary General announced the list of Obituaries for the year 2020-21. Among them were Dr. Bhat Ganapathi Devaru from Hubli, Dr.Jayaprakash from Subbaiah Medical College Shivamoga, Dr. Michael Stanley from Coimbatore, Dr. Nagaraj from Tumkur. One minute silence was observed as a mark of respect to the departed souls.

The Secretary General Readout the Secretary's Report which was as follows:

At the outset I thank all the KOA members for having extended a wonderful cooperation through the 3nd year of my office as Secretary General of the KOA.

My sincere thanks to our Beloved President Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy for his support and cooperation in the conduct of the day-to-day affairs of the KOA, My sincere thanks to Dr. K.M. Gopinath, Treasurer KOA for his meticulous maintenance of the financial affairs of KOA, and seamless handling of the financial matters of KOA.

With the support of the President Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy and all other district association presidents & EC members who assisted in conducting Online meetings & Webinars of all the committees constituted by the KOA.

Total number of members of KOA at present is 1,683., Total number of new members enrolled during 2019-20 is 37, Total number of IOA members enrolled from Karnataka during 2019-20 is 09.

I have represented Karnataka in all the meetings of OASIS and also the CSRC & EC meetings of the IOA, and have presented report of KOA.

We did not select any fellows for being sent to the KOA's "Surekha Memorial Inland Travelling Fellowship" due to COVID19 pandemic restrictions.

We had no selection of fellow for "Bisal Muddu International Travelling Fellowship" as well this year.

This year we conducted over 56 CME programs of various topics and from various institutes, all of them were online mode.

We were supposed to have KOA ICL this year which will be conducted at Gokak (dates will be announced soon).

As a part of the charity the bone and joint week was successfully carried out throughout the state under the KOA banner, Radio talks, Extensive Online webinars, Awareness programs were few to mention apart from free surgeries were also conducted and reported to IOA.

Under the presidentship of Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy, 6 EC meetings, 2 Central Conference Committee meetings were held this year. Apart from these various committees constituted by the president met regularly. All meetings were virtual ones.

E-Newsletters were published two volumes (hard copy discontinued as per decision taken in AGM). KOA website domain was renewed.

Our website is updated with fresh looks & interactive platforms where doctors can interact and also patients could participate apart from patients finding their doctors on our web site.

The Journal of KOA was printed as well as e-Journal was also published by chief editor Dr. Anil Bhat.

As per the Decision of the AGM, we have continued the online voting this year for the Elections of the KOA, alongside the postal ballots.

We have received around 36 new membership applications this year.

The Secretary's report was passed by the house.

The Treasurer Dr. Gopinath presented the KOA accounts for the FY 2019-20:

The KOA account at Bangalore is held with Syndicate Bank Vijayanagar, which now has got merged with Canara bank. The opening balance was 4,11,535/- as on 1st April 2019. 10,81,156/- as on 31st march 2020.

We have 7 FDs held with above bank total amount amounting to 1,48,23,285/-

Total income this year was 15 lacs, expenses were 11 lacs, (FD interest accrued was 9.6 Lacs)

The Conference Chairman Dr. Muralidhar presented an amount of 5,36,624/- from the conference KOACON 2019.

Detailed Accounts handouts were handed over to the audience.

Dr. Sachhidanand Rai suggested to get 12A status allotted, so that no tax could be payable. But the members from the house deliberated and was said that 12A status is given to only charitable trusts that use their funds only for such purpose. We cannot have such huge balance and also have 12A simultaneously. Dr. Ravindra mentioned that there is no need to have a 12A status as we are collecting money for the benefit of members and welfare. He also felt & suggested that most of the daily running expenses of the association should be done from the money received from the KOACON conferences and not to use up the interest obtained from the FDs. Such interest amounts can be utilized for awards, and other academic findings.

The accounts were passed by the house after deliberations.

The Chairman of the KOACON 2020 Dr. Ashwini Kumar Singh, presented the KOACON 2020 details of accounts on behalf of his treasurer, and also presented a cheque of 5,45,000/- to KOA from conference. It was appreciated & applauded by the house.

There was a proposal to change over the donation from KOACON conferences from existing 5Lac rupees minimum to a percentage-based donations. Lot of Deliberations went on and finally it was proposed by Dr. Sachidananda Rai to adopt a 5% of total collected money to be contributed to KOA from that conference. It was passed by Dr. Deepak Shivanna.

The Secretary general Presented the report of the KOA elections for 2020-21. the report was as follows:

14. Report of KOA elections 2021 by Secretary general:

This being the third year of online election along with the ballots, we had received three applications for the posts of President elect 2022 Dr. Ashwini Kumar Singh & Dr. Harish Murthy & Dr. Anil Patil. There were only 5 applications for the EC posts. There was one Application for the Secretary General Post.

Hence election was initiated only for president elect post by online as well as ballot votes.

There were two applications for the KOACON-2023 venue, Belgaum & Bijapur, the selection of the same was made possible through the ballot vote & Online modes.

On the online aspect of the elections, as in the last year we had ensured multiple layers of security for the online voting process, and the whole process was working seamlessly and many members expressed satisfaction about the online system adopted for voting.

During the process the technical difficulties faced by some members in exercising their franchise were promptly attended by me. I have been continuously on the job of updating and reformatting the whole membership database of KOA members, even after updating the member's database there are still many wrong / incomplete information about many members.

This is primarily because members after changing their address or phone or mail ids, they are not communicating with the secretariat. I request all members to kindly keep updating your details in case of any changes.

We had posted 1683 ballots to the members, Total Voting was 1100 numbers, Online votes were 959, 141 ballots came back with vote, 98 ballots returned undelivered, while, 6 ballots were disqualified because they had voted online also and 3 Ballots were disqualified for other technical reasons.

After final counting of both online & postal ballots, Dr. Ashwini Kumar Singh received 411 votes while Dr. Anil Patil got 386 & Dr. Harish Murthy got 300 Votes. **Dr. Ashwini Kumar Singh was declared as the President Elect 2022**.

Dr. Bharath Raju G. was unanimously elected as Secretary General of KOA.

The Following members were elected as EC members:

Dr. Sreepad Kulkarni, Dr. Sachidananda Rai, Dr. Abdul Khader, Dr. Shiva Naik, Dr. Puneeth.

Belgaum was declared as the venue for KOACON 2023

The House took a unanimous decision and passed that henceforth from year 2021 onwards there will be only online elections and the ballot votes will be discontinued.

The President Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy put forth the Proposals of his EC for approval by the House. The proposals were-To start research grants for consultants, to give best Paper award to consultants, to give best outgoing PG award, to give Best Thesis award. Incoming president also added that he wants to institute Fellowship training for young consultants in 5 sub specialty branches for 1 month duration for which he sought some financial help from KOA. Hearing to all these, and after deliberations the house concluded that let a committee be formed by the president, and that committee will work on the feasibilities & possibilities of the above proposal and present the facts at the EGM to be held at Hassan KOACON2021 conference in June 2021.

Regarding the CA site for KOA, the previous AGM had given the responsibility to the president and Dr. Chandrashekar to find a CA site. But due to changes in the Government policies, CA sites can no more be got on lease, instead have to be purchased after bidding from the government, this option may not be affordable by KOA at present. So, a new proposal was suggested by Dr. Chandrashekar that if BOS (Bangalore Orthopedic Society) is willing to buy a site or a piece of land (maybe 1 acre) KOA can have its building in that land with understanding with BOS. This proposal was liked by most of the members present, and the house passed the proposal. Now KOA will wait to hear from the BOS about the proposal which will be conveyed to BOS through few members who are also KOA members. This matter will be relooked again at Hassan Conference.

Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy proposed that KOA bid for IOACON 2024. Dr. Purushotham opined that there is no need to bid as the conference will come to KOA automatically on rotation in 2024. So, it was decided by the house that the KOA will bid/conduct if the chance comes to KOA in 2024. the IOACON should be held in Bangalore only considering the logistics. Dr. Rajkumar Amaravathy briefed the house about KOACON 2022 at St. Johns to be held in February of 2022.

Dr. Sreeranga briefed about the forthcoming KOACON to be held by physical mode in June 4,5,6th 2021 at Hassan.

The KOA change of guard took place by Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy outgoing president handing over the KOA medallion to president elect Dr. Chandrashekar. Dr. Chandrashekar President KOA 2021-22 took over office and made his presentation to the AGM about his theme vision and plans for the coming year.

Vote of thanks was delivered by Dr. Gopinath.

AGM concluded with National Anthem.

















KOACON 2021



The 45th Annual Conference of Karnataka Orthopaedic Association "KOACON 2021" was held at Hassan Institute of Medical Sciences on 30th & 31st July 2021.

The conference was inaugurated by **Paramapujya Jagadguru Sri Sri Sri Nirmalanandanatha Swamiji** with **Dr B.C. Ravikumar,** Director of Hassan Medical College **as Guest of Honour** and **IOA President Dr. Shivashankar** as **Special Invitee** along with the KOA Office Bearers.

Three senior KOA members felicitated for their life time achievement - Dr. T.R. Nagaraj from Hassan, Dr. J.S. Hegde from Mysuru & Dr. J.N. Sridharamurthy from Bengaluru.

The Past KOA Secretary Generals Dr. Ravishankar and Dr. Roshan Kumar were also felicitated.



Though the conference was to be held in February, due to the pandemic it was postponed. Due to Covid restrictions it was conducted on a Virtual Platform. There were 466 registrations (Delegates - 416 & Faculty - 50).

The Free Paper & E-poster session was held on the forenoon of 30th July which included the session of Gold paper presentation of 10 papers. A whooping 206 Free papers were presented in 5 virtual halls & 192 E-posters were virtually displayed. 4 Gold Paper presenters & 3 E-posters were selected as prize winners.

It was followed by CME sessions on - "Intra Articular Fractures around the Joints" for the postgraduates & junior doctors.





On 31st July Dr. Verghese Chacko Oration was delivered by Dr. Ajit Kumar from Mangalore, the Presidential Address by Dr. B. Mallikarjunaswamy, Dr. Shyamsundar Shetty Oration was delivered by IOA president Dr. Shivashankar.









There were various subspeciality sessions on Hand, Arthroplasty, Arthroscopy, Tumour, Foot & Ankle, spine, Paediatric Orthopaedics & Medicolegal Aspects.

The KOA Lamp was handed over to the organising team of KOACON 2022.

KOA-ICL 2020

The KOA Instructional Course Lecture 2020 which was postponed due to the pandemic was held on 3rd and 4th of April 2021 at the KLE Centenary Hall, Belagavi. It was hosted by the Belagavi Orthopaedic Surgeons Welfare Society, Dept. of Orthopaedics J.N. Medical College and Dept. of Orthopaedics BIMS Belagavi was prestigious.


The Theme of the ICL was "HIP & KNEE ARTHROPLASTY-BACK TO BASICS".

It was a physical event with 198 registrations and 160+ doctors participated in the Conference, with about 20 guest speakers from around the state of Karnataka. The conference also saw a good number of trade partners participating and supporting the event.

Dr. B. Mallikarjunaswamy, President KOA inaugurated the conference along with Dr. Bharath Raju G., Secretary General KOA and the proceedings was addressed by the Organizing Chairman Dr. Anil B. Patil. While the Organizing Secretary gave the Vote of Thanks. The function was presided by eminent doctors from the institution and KOA office bearers.

The scientific program was spread across 2 days with Eminent speakers from across Karnataka delivering notable presentations. The course covered salient topics in Primary Hip and Knee Replacement surgery. The didactic lectures in Knee Arthroplasty with focus on Contemporary Standard of Care and Current Options in Patient selection, preoperative planning, Principles of Deformity correction, Preventing Periprosthetic Infections and Avoiding complications. Also included is a session on TKR alternatives like Biological interventions for adult knee problems, Role of Osteotomy and Arthroscopy. A hands-on Workshop was organized to demonstrate the technical aspects of the surgery and was also the highlight of the course.

The conference was concluded with a valedictory function thanking the entire Organizing team along with prize distribution for the Free Paper Presentations.








KOA PG TEACHING PROGRAM

Karnataka Orthopaedic Association along with the District Chapters conducted various programs during the Bone and Joint Week from 1st to 7th of August, 2021.


A theme-based webinar on "SAVE SELF - SAVE ONE" was organised on 4th of August, 2021. The same was reported in the print media.

















