

Minutes of the KOA AGM 2022

Date: 05-03-2022

Hybrid Mode: Venue: - Hotel Royal Fort, Ballari on Zoom Platform

Attended by: Physical: - 28.

Online: - 150.

The meeting was supposed to start at 03.30pm, as there was no quorum it was postponed by 15 minutes.

The meeting started at 03.45pm after the quorum was reached with an invocation song and lighting of the lamp.

The President, Dr. H.S. Chandrashekar called the house to order.

The Secretary General, Dr. Bharath Raju G. welcomed the members present physically as well as online to the Annual General Body Meeting of Karnataka Orthopaedic Association and thanked all the members for giving an opportunity to serve as the Secretary General.

The Secretary General read out the **Obituaries** in the year 2021 – 2022. Dr. K.V.P. Rao (Membership No. R-17) from Ballari and Dr. D.N. Erappa Reddy (Membership No. E-1) from Bengaluru. Dr. Srinivas from Ballari spoke about Dr. K.V.P. Rao and Dr. Nithyanand Rao N. spoke about Dr. D.N. Erappa Reddy. A minute of silence was observed as a mark of respect to the departed souls.

Dr. H.S. Chandrashekar, President KOA gave the **Presidential Address**. He welcomed the gathering and thanked all the members for the cooperation during his tenure as President. He mentioned about the various activities planned after he took over as President on 06th February 2021.

The Presidential Theme was “Perfection Through Precision”. Many programs like Training of young orthopaedic surgeons, PG training program, CMEs and Workshop in district and taluks of the state were planned.

A Cadaveric Workshop was conducted in April at Tumkur just before the second wave of Covid. A short-term fellowship of one month was started in Spine, Sports Medicine, Arthroplasty, Advanced Trauma and Paediatric Orthopaedics which was availed by 34 orthopaedic surgeons. Monthly webinars were conducted regularly with International, National and State faculties. PG Teaching Programs were also regularly conducted in all the three zones.

KOA ICL 2021 was planned at Bagalkot and was converted to virtual ICL due to the third wave of covid.

The President mentioned that KOACON 2022 is postponed and asked all the members to attend the same and make it a success.

The President mentioned about the efforts to procure a CA site for KOA and said he would work for the same in future. The President mentioned about the resolutions passed by the EC to have a permanent Secretariat Office and Office Secretary.

The **Secretary General's Report** was read out by Dr. Bharath Raju G. He thanked the President, for all the support extended. The Secretary General also thanked the Past President, Past Secretary General, President Elect, OASIS Vice President, Joint Secretary, Treasurer, the Editor Journal of KOA, Executive Committee Members and the KOA Coordinators for their support and cooperation.

The Secretary General mentioned that he took charge as the Secretary General on the 01st of April 2021, along with Dr. Satish Shervegar as Joint Secretary and Dr. Ravish V.N. as Treasurer.

The Secretary General mentioned that the renewal of the Association pending for the past 2 years due to Covid was done.

The Secretary General mentioned that the 45th annual conference of KOA, KOACON 2021 was postponed and conducted in a Virtual mode on 30th and 31st of July at Hassan. There was a total of 466 registrations. The conference was inaugurated by Jagaduru Sri Sri Sri Nirmalanandanatha Swamiji along with Dr. B. Shivashankar, President IOA as guest of honour. The senior members Dr. T.R. Nagaraj from Hassan, Dr. J.S. Hegde from Mysuru and Dr. J.N. Sridharamurthy from Bengaluru were felicitated along with the Past Secretary Generals Dr. Ravishankar, Dr. Edward Nazareth and Dr. B.N. Roshan Kumar. The Presidential Oration was delivered by Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy B., Dr. Varghese Chacko Oration was delivered by Dr. Ajith Kumar M. and Dr. Shyam Sundar Shetty Oration was delivered by Dr. B. Shivashankar. The detailed report to be presented by the Organising Secretary of KOACON 2021.

The Secretary General mentioned that the first event he attended was the KOA ICL 2020 with the theme “Hip and Knee Arthroplasty – Back to Basics” which was postponed to the 3rd and 4th of April 2021 at Belagavi. It was inaugurated by Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy B. Past President of KOA and attended by about 200 delegates.

The Secretary General mentioned that the KOA ICL 2021 with the theme “Pearls on Paediatric Orthopaedics” was planned on the 4th and 5th of December 2021 at Bagalkot but had to be converted to virtual meet on the 4th of December due to the outbreak of the third wave of covid. It was inaugurated by Dr. H.S. Chandrashekar, President KOA and attended by about 200 delegates.

The Secretary General mentioned that a one-month short term fellowship was started by the President in Spine, Sports Medicine, Arthroplasty, Advanced Trauma and Paediatric Orthopaedics which was availed by 34 orthopaedic surgeons.

“Smt. Surekha Rajendra Memorial Inland Fellowship, “Bisal Muddu International Travelling Fellowship” and “KOA Trauma Travelling Fellowship” programs were not conducted this year due to the pandemic.

The Secretary General mentioned that Webinars were regularly conducted every month by Dr. Satish Shervegar. Ten webinars have been conducted with international, national and state faculties.

The Secretary General mentioned that the PG teaching programs were conducted in Hybrid format by Dr. Ramesh Krishna as the coordinator. Six programs have been conducted in all the zones by rotation.

The Secretary General mentioned that only one physical CME and Workshop was conducted on Pelvi-Acetabular fractures at Tumkur by Dr. Deepak Shivanna as the coordinator along with Tumkur Orthopaedic Society. It was inaugurated by Dr. H.S. Chandrashekar and attended by about 40 delegates.

The Secretary General mentioned that the Bone and Joint Week was observed from the 1st to 7th of August 2021 with the theme “Save Self Save One”. A theme-based webinar was organised on the 4th of August, speakers were Dr. Shantharam Shetty, Dr. V.J. Purushotham, Dr. Arvind M.N., Mr. Guruprashanth P.

The various District chapters conducted programs during the week. BLS training was conducted for about 100 police personnel, 500 medicos and paramedical students, 4000 school and college students. Symposia on Trauma and Lifestyle training along with BMD camps were organized.

The Secretary General mentioned that 6 Executive Committee meetings have been conducted this year, 2 in hybrid mode and 4 in virtual platform. Two Conference Committee meetings of KOACON 2022 have been conducted.

The Secretary General mentioned that only one KOA bulletin has been published this year due to few activities conducted.

The Secretary General mentioned that two issues of the Journal of KOA have been published.

The Secretary General mentioned that the website has been redesigned and a community page along with a job portal have been added.

The Secretary General mentioned that a record 111 KOA membership applications have been received. OASIS memberships ratified are 36, IOA memberships ratified are 49 (46 – Life, 3 – Associate).

The Secretary General mentioned that he has represented and presented state reports at all OASIS EC meetings. OASIS Traumacon 2021 was hosted by KOA and one OASIS ICL was conducted by KOA. He attended the 20th Annual Conference of OASIS on the 24th & 25th of September 2021 at Salem. Dr. Ashok Kalamdani from Hubli was felicitated for Lifetime Achievement.

The Secretary General mentioned that he has represented and presented state reports at all the IOA EC meetings and CSRC meetings. As a member of the IOA Trauma Committee organized IOA Trauma Ki Paathshala. Attended IOACON 2021 the 66th Annual Conference of IOA from the 21st to 25th of December 2021 at Goa and presented the CSRC - Vision IOA.

The Secretary General mentioned the District Chapter activities. Attended the “CME and Hands on Workshop in Basics of Illizarov Technique” conducted at Kamakshi Hospitals, Mysore under the aegis of KOA and MOA on 10th October 2021. Mysore Orthopaedic Association launched their new Logo at the inaugural ceremony.

KIMS CME-2021 on Shoulder Trauma and Arthroscopy was conducted on 27th November 2021 at KIMS Hubli under the aegis of KOA and HDOA.

Shoulder Conclave 2022 was conducted at Kanachur Institute of Medical Sciences on 22nd January 2022 under the aegis of KOA and COS.

11th Dr. M. Sudhakar Shetty Memorial 39th Mangalore Orthopaedic Course was conducted from 18th to 20th of February 2022 under the aegis of KOA and COS.

The Secretary General thanked all the members.

The Secretary General's report was passed by the house. Proposed by Dr. Uday Kumar and seconded by Dr. Gururaj Murgod.

The **KOA Treasurer's Report** was presented by the Treasurer Dr. V.N. Ravish. A few members asked for the copy of the audited accounts. The Secretary General said that since the account statements were mailed to all the members twice and with the initiative of going green, the printed copies were not circulated.

The Treasurer read out the Balance Sheet as on 31st March 2021 and the Income and Expenditure Account for the year ended 31st March 2021. The excess of Income over Expenditure of Rs. 7,98,013 has been transferred to the general fund. The Term Deposits – 6 with the Secretariat and 1 of the KOA Oration Fund with Dr. Sharath Rao was presented to the AGM.

The Treasurer's Report was passed by the house. Proposed by Dr. Sachidananda Rai and seconded by Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy B.

The **KOA ICL 2020** report was presented by the Organising Secretary Dr. Gangadhar Umarani. The accounts were presented. The report was passed, proposed by Dr. Narendra and seconded by Dr. Ram Subba Reddy.

The **KOACON 2021** report and accounts were presented by the Organising Secretary Dr. Sreeranga. A detailed report of the conference conducted in a hybrid format was presented. A CME on Intra Articular Fractures was conducted. The accounts of the conference were presented and a total of Rs.30,49,186/- was the income. The expenditure was Rs. 27,91,999/-. The balance amount is Rs. 2,57,187/-. He expressed that Rs. 1,00,000/- will be handed over to KOA. The President mentioned that it was passed in the previous AGM that the organising committee has to contribute 5% of the collected amount to KOA, hence the President asked the Organising Secretary to hand over Rs. 1,50,000/-. The same was passed by the house. Proposed by Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy B. and seconded by Dr. Srinivas.

The **KOA ICL 2021** report was presented by the Organising Secretary Dr. Girish Naikwadi. The ICL was conducted on a virtual platform and was attended by about 200 delegates. The report was passed, proposed by Dr. Vinod Kumar and seconded by Dr. Avinash Parthasarathy.

The report and results of the **KOA Elections 2022**. The Secretary General read out the notification of KOA Elections 2022 and mentioned that a printed nomination form was used for the first time. The elections were completely online for the first time.

Two nominations were received for one post of President Elect 2022 – 2023: Dr. Edward L. Nazareth and Dr. Ramesh Krishna K.

Dr. Ramesh Krishna withdrew his nomination.

Two nominations were received for KOACON 2024 venue: Mysuru (MOA) and Shivamogga (SOS).

Six nominations were received for six posts of Executive Committee members: Dr. Yathiraju T., Dr. Narayan Swamy Nayak, Dr. Srinivas N., Dr. Vikram Shetty, Dr. Rudramuni A.K. and Dr. Gaurav M.

Elections were held only for KOACON 2024 venue.

Total Votes polled was 617.

Mysuru received 279 (45.2%) and Shivamogga received 338 (54.8%).

The house passed the KOA Elections 2022 report and results. Proposed by Dr. Abdul Khader and seconded by Dr. Shiva Naik.

The **Ratification of the Minutes of the AGM 2021** held on 6th February 2021 at Hotel Ramanashree, Bengaluru. The Secretary General presented the minutes of the previous AGM. The house passed the AGM minutes, proposed by Dr. A.M. Radhakrishna and seconded by Dr. Vinod.

The **Executive Committee 2021 - 2022 Resolutions for AGM approval**. The Secretary General read out the EC resolutions of the year 2021 - 2022.

1. **IOACON 2024:** KOA shall bid for IOACON 2024 at Bengaluru, which was passed in the previous AGM. The house ratified the same, proposed by Dr. Aswani Kumar Singh and seconded by Dr. Nithyanand Rao N. The Organising Committee to have representation from all the 3 zones of KOA. The Organising Committee shall be formed by the resolution of the Executive Committee of KOA. A professional event management company to be hired for IOACON 2024 campaign purpose. The house passed the same, proposed by Dr. Shantharam Shetty and seconded by Dr. Mallikarjunaswamy B.

2. Postponement of KOACON 2021 and Postponement of KOACON 2022 to the first week of May 2022. The house passed the same, proposed by Dr. Anil Patil and seconded by Dr. Narayan Swamy Nayak.
3. **KOA Website:** Renewal and updation. Appointing Dr. Satya Vamsi Krishna, Bengaluru as KOA Website Coordinator by the EC for 3 years. The house passed the same, proposed by Dr. Uday Kumar and seconded by Dr. Madan Ballal.
4. **Journal of KOA:** In view of duplicate submission of articles to the Journal, the Editor of JKOA has prepared Journal Guidelines. The Editor of JKOA Dr. Anil K. Bhat mentioned that JKOA has been the flagship academic activity of KOA. The Journal has been indexed by Index Copernicus and the DOAJ indexing is in process. The team of the journal have been working hard to maintain highest standards. The concerns of academic misconduct were Duplicate Publications and improper submission by postgraduates of their entire thesis for NMC purpose. The Journal follows Committee of Publication Ethics (COPE) guidelines, which is mentioned in the JKOA website. The members to guide their postgraduates regarding the same and avoid academic misconduct. In case of any academic misconduct the author will be blacklisted, and the publication will be withdrawn. The house passed the same, proposed by Dr. Gururaj Murgod and seconded by Dr. Srinivas.
5. The dormant JKOA account which was opened by the past Editor to be closed and the amount in the account to be transferred to the KOA main account. The house passed the same, proposed by Dr. Anil Patil and seconded by Dr. Vinod Kumar.
6. **KOA Auditor:** The previous auditor C.S. Harish & Co. to be continued for the next 3 years. The house passed the same, proposed by Dr. Sachidananda Rai and seconded by Dr. Rajagopal.
7. **KOA Election Vendor:** The previous vendor A1 Logics to be continued for next 3 years. Dr. Gururaj Murgod suggested going for a tender process for appointing the vendor. The President Elect Dr. Aswani Kumar Singh mentioned that the vendor has done the trial run for 3 years and the safety features were ascertained hence the EC has resolved to continue the vendor. The President mentioned that the tender process will take about 3 - 6 months and to ascertain the credentials of the vendor placing the bids require time hence to continue this vendor for another 2 years and start tendering process by then. The Secretary General highlighted that the same matter was discussed along with the lack guidelines in the KOA Constitution for Online Elections and after a lot of deliberation the EC resolved to continue with the same vendor for 3 years. Dr. Shantharam Shetty said that the most important criteria of online elections is the safety and security feature, the said vendor has won the bid previously and conducted the trial runs with utmost secure features. He also said there has been no issues or concerns with the present vendor. After a lot of deliberations by the members and the President assuring the house to formulate guidelines by the next 2 years, the house passed the matter. Proposed by Dr. Radhakrishna and seconded by Dr. Madan Ballal.
8. **OASIS Membership Fee:** OASIS wants to increase the membership fees from the current Rs. 200/- to Rs. 500/-. The President suggested that the matter was discussed in the OASIS AGM, and he had opposed the same and it will be subject to KOA AGM decision. Dr. Shantharam Shetty mentioned that since all the other member states have agreed KOA should accept the same. The matter was deliberated at length. The house decided that the Membership Fee of KOA shall remain the same and an additional Rs. 500/- to be paid for OASIS Membership for Orthopaedic Surgeons applying for KOA Membership plus the GST. It was decided that the Membership Fee of KOA henceforth will be Rs. 3000/- (KOA Membership + OASIS Membership + GST). Proposed by Dr. Shantharam Shetty and seconded by Dr. Nithyanand Rao.
9. **Incidental Charges:** To increase the incidental charges in the conference registration fees of KOACON from Rs. 200/- to Rs. 500/-. The members deliberated on the matter. The President proposed that the amount can be increased to Rs. 300/-. The house passed the increase of KOACON Incidental Charges from Rs. 200- to Rs. 300/-. The matter was deliberated at length and decided to have a permanent Office Secretary at the Secretariat. The house passed the resolution, proposed by Dr. Abdul Khader and seconded by Harish.

The **Ratification of New Membership applications.** The Secretary General mentioned that a record of 111 new membership applications have been received and presented the list of applicants. The house ratified the applications, proposed by Dr. Gururaj Murgod and seconded by Dr. Avinash Parthasarathy.

Any **Other Matters** with the permission of the Chair. 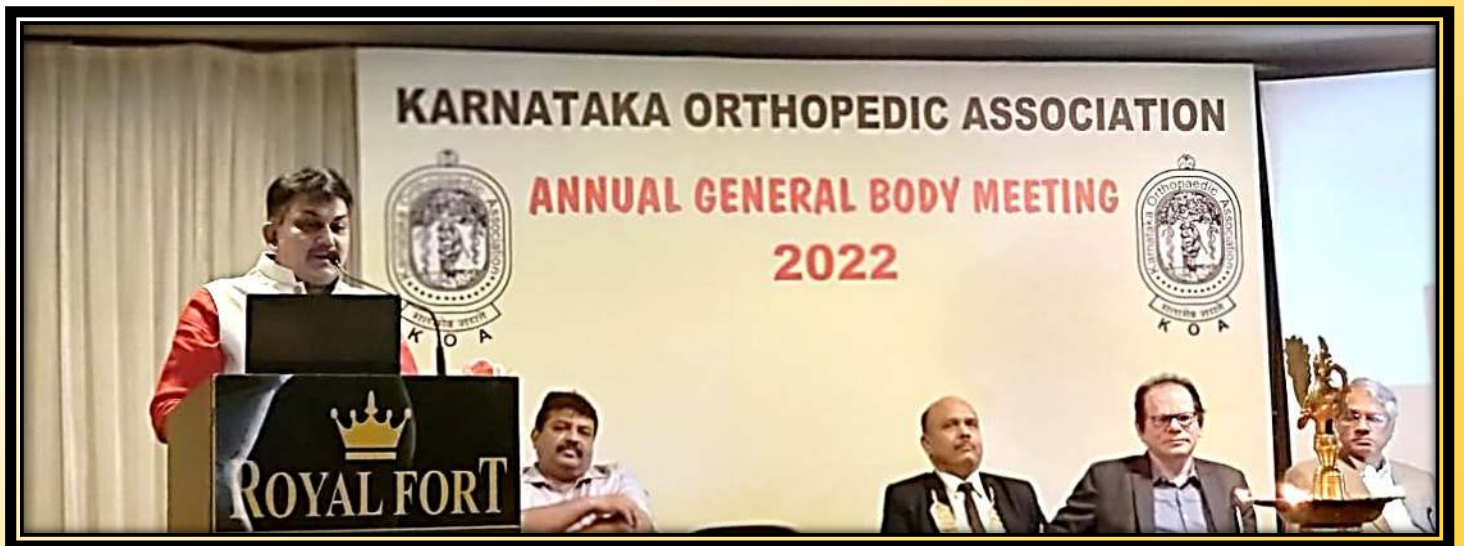

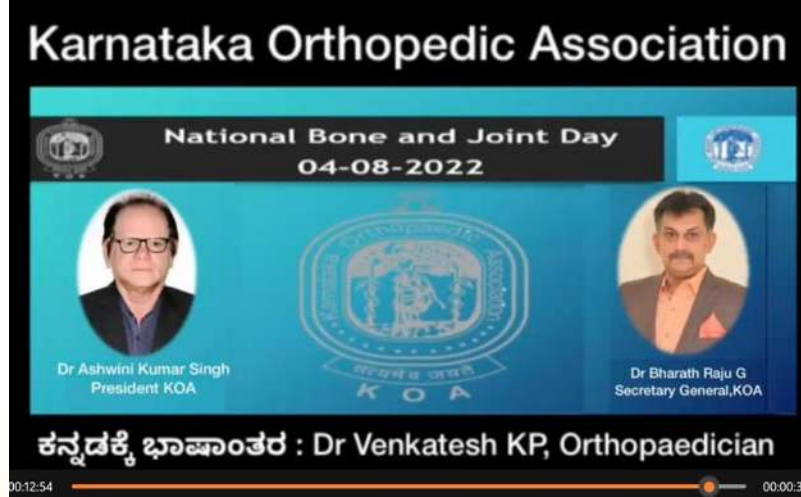


KOA Bone and Joint Week 2022

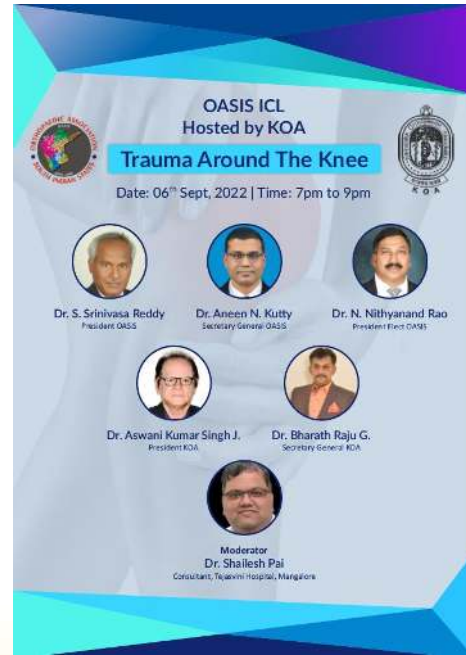

Introduction

Karnataka Orthopaedic Association proudly announces its 14th Bisal Muddu International Travel Fellowship Programme for the year 2023. The earlier fellowship programmes have received huge response and acclaim from the members and also from the host consultants in the United Kingdom. The travelling fellows have had a memorable taste of both academic exposure and a travel experience.

This Programme is recognized and supported by British Indian Orthopedic Society (UK). The member consultants will be hosting the travelling fellows during the Programme.

This programme is mainly aimed at encouraging young enterprising Orthopedic Surgeons who lack an international exposure in their academic field. The Fellows will be visiting various centers of excellence in the United Kingdom

It is to be noted that the fellows selected for the 13th BITF- 2020 Programme were not able to travel due to the Pandemic and the fellowship Programme was stopped for 2 years. In order to compensate for the two years loss, the BIOS (U.K) has agreed to increase the fellowship number to six this year and thus pilot it for further years accordingly.

OBJECTIVES:

Selection Criteria

The criteria of selection will be based on the application form / Curriculum Vitae and the points scored as per the application format.
